Anthony C. Spikes is the Managing Principal and CEO of Sapphire Hill Global Partners, a global-macro investment firm he founded in 2009. He also serves as Co-CEO and Co-Portfolio Manager of Harbor Hill Advisors, a joint venture between the investment firms of Sapphire Hill Global and Iron Harbor Capital Management. Mr. Spikes is also a member of the Advisory Committee to the CEO of the PGA of America.

Mr. Spikes has over 20 years of experience in the investment and finance industry. Including his law background Mr. Spikes has over 24 years of experience in law and finance.

Mr. Spikes experience in the investment industry includes positions at Goldman Sachs, Citigroup and Conquest Strategies. As a Vice President at Goldman Sachs, Mr. Spikes managed in excess of \$4 billion across asset classes within Goldman's Private Wealth Division. Following Goldman, Mr. Spikes served as a Director of Investment Banking at Citigroup where he structured private equity financing for companies within the Financial Services, Consumer and Healthcare industries. Notable deals that he worked on were the merger of Reynolds and Reynolds Company with Universal Computer Systems, Inc., the funding of European Capital Strategies and Steve and Barry's, the latter two deals receiving notable awards within Citigroup. Prior to founding Sapphire Hill Global, Mr. Spikes joined the investment firm Conquest Strategies where he was Co-Portfolio Manager and Chief Financial Officer.

Prior to Goldman Sachs, Mr. Spikes developed his finance expertise within healthcare and aerospace as a Director in the Microgravity and Life Sciences Division of Spacehab Inc., at the NASA Johnson Space Center in Houston, Texas. Besides serving as CFO for the division and Assistant Corporate Counsel, Mr. Spikes primarily focused on structuring private equity investments in pharmaceutical and biotech firms on behalf of Spacehab. Mr. Spikes began his career as In-House Counsel and Trust Officer at Colorado National Bank in Denver, Colorado and worked as a junior portfolio manager for Alexander Capital Management also in Denver, Colorado.

Mr. Spikes sits on the Boards of International House of New York and the Metropolitan Golf Association Foundation.
